

Put your feet up, relax - have a **Sundowner!**

SUNDOWNER is a new addition to the Lefroy Valley tomato range. **SUNDOWNER** has high resistance to V, Fol1,2, N, TSWV & Rs, and intermediate resistance to Lt, Pst & Xcv. The variety has proven itself through rigorous trials in the Goulbourn Valley in northern Victoria and in the Perth metro area in WA. This is no sensitive little thoroughbred - but is a tough hybrid designed for testing open-field conditions and high disease pressure.



SUNDOWNER performed well in Perth through hot summer conditions and high TSWV pressure in semi commercial trials, and the first commercial plantings will go ahead in the 2007 /2008 summer season. Plants produced up to 14 trusses under open field conditions and maintained fruit size right to the top of the vine.



After an extended hot period in Shepparton, **SUNDOWNER** remained firm and produced the highest quality fruit in the trials, even after heavy rain showers.

SUNDOWNER has a distinctly lower nitrogen requirement than greenhouse Dutch bred varieties. The vigorous vine needs to be allowed to set fruit on the first truss at the bottom of the vine before nitrogen levels are increased as the crop load increases. Under tough conditions **SUNDOWNER** has the unique ability to produce high yields of good quality fruit.

So relax, take it easy, put your feet up, have a **SUNDOWNER** and let genetics help sort out your disease problems.
