

# Be on the lookout for DRW 7589



In its first trial season **DRW 7589** has shown outstanding promise to start up the season in Bundaberg and Bowen. This new indeterminate tomato from the De Ruiter Seeds stable brings an outstanding disease package including resistance to nematodes, TSWV, F3 and the newly identified Torrado Virus.

This coupled to high yield potential and high quality gourmet fruit with no green shoulder makes this variety an exciting prospect.

## **Trials & Disease Package**

Initial trials have shown that this variety has the ability to produce high fruit numbers in the size range of 160 – 180g.

The disease package will also be handy for other production areas as trials have been planted in northern Victoria, South Australia and Western Australia in the open field, and trials are also under way in unheated greenhouses in the Sydney basin and South Australia.

**Be on the lookout for larger trials in central and north Queensland in the Autumn of 2009.**
