DYNAMO has the vigour which makes it highly suited to cool season production in subtropical areas. Dark green cylindrical fruit are produced early and quality is maintained throughout the harvest period.

Plant: Vigorous but semi open plants allowing for easy harvest

Fruit: Dark green. Straight and cylindrical

Disease: Intermediately Resistant to WMV II & ZYMV

Pack Size: 3000 & 55,000 seeds

Key: WMV II – Watermelon Mosaic Virus
ZYMV - Zucchini Yellow Mosaic Virus

Intermediately resistant plant varieties would restrict the growth and development of the specified pest or pathogen. The plant variety may however exhibit a greater range or degree of symptoms when compared to a highly resistant variety. Intermediately resistant plant varieties will still show less severe symptoms or disease damage than susceptible plant varieties when the crop is grown under similar environmental conditions and is subjected to the same disease or pest pressure.
