## **GATLIN**

**Gatlin Lettuce is a new crisphead variety that has excelled in the eastern States, from Adelaide, through Victoria and in South East Queensland. It has excellent uniformity and good adaptability. The medium green head has consistent heart fill. The neat frame allows it to be used as a crate lettuce, but is also suited to prepack heads and processing.**

**Gatlin has performed well in both spring and autumn harvest slots in Adelaide and Werribee. In the Lockyer**

**Valley it has performed very well harvesting June to September.**

**Gatlin has intermediate resistance to Corky Root (*Rhizomonas suberifaciens*) and is highly resistant Downy Mildew BI 1-16, 18, 21, & 23.**

## **LEC 6348**

**LEC 6348 crisphead lettuce variety has produced excellent results in late summer and early autumn in Queensland and Adelaide.**

**It is a Vanguard type lettuce with a large frame and large heads, with good density and external colour. It has strong tolerance to tipburn, early maturity and excellent uniformity. We are continuing to trial it through the summer.**
