

## SUNDOWNER F1



- highly resistant to TSWV, and Bacterial Wilt
- good vigour and size
- strong disease package

**Sundowner** is a vigorous indeterminate tomato with a strong disease resistance package. Fruit is 140 -170g in size with no green shoulder and good size is maintained to the top of the vine. Suitable for difficult production areas where there is high TSWV pressure.

<b>Plant:</b>	Vigorous indeterminate plant, avoid overfeeding with N fertiliser. Good cool season vigour.
<b>Fruit:</b>	140 to 170g uniform large size to the top of the vine.
<b>Colour:</b>	Deep red with no green shoulder.
<b>Shape:</b>	Flattened globe with smooth shoulder not susceptible to cracking or russetting
<b>Characteristics:</b>	A highly adaptable variety with an extensive disease package, able to perform and provide good yield under stressful conditions.
<b>Disease:</b>	HR to ToMV, TSWV, Fol 0,1, Va, Rs IR to Lt, Mj
<b>Shelf life:</b>	Naturally extended shelf life
<b>Key:</b>	Fol 0,1 - Fusarium wilt races 1 & 2    ToMV - Tomato mosaic virus TSWV - Tomato spotted wilt virus    Va - Verticillium wilt ( <i>Verticillium albo-atrum</i> ) Rs - Bacterial wilt    Lt - Powdery Mildew    Mj - Nematode ( <i>Meloidogyne javanica</i> )

**Intermediately resistant** plant varieties would restrict the growth and development of the specified pest or pathogen. The plant variety may however exhibit a greater range or degree of symptoms when compared to a highly resistant variety. Intermediately resistant plant varieties will still show less severe symptoms or disease damage than susceptible plant varieties when the crop is grown under similar environmental conditions and is subjected to the same disease or pest pressure.

**Highly resistant** plant varieties would highly restrict the growth and development of the specified pest or pathogen under normal growing conditions and pest pressure when compared to susceptible varieties. These plant varieties may, however, exhibit some symptoms or damage under heavy pest pressure or stressful growing conditions.
