- Compact plants
- Large blocky yellow fruit
- Xv resistant

Helios yields large blocky (9x9cm to 10x10cm) yellow fruit on compact bushes. May be grown openfield without support. Has HR to ToMV, Xv1,2,3, PVY.

Plant:	Compact sturdy plant with good cover
Fruit:	Green to bright yellow blocky , 9 x 9cm to 10 x 10cm.
Characteristics:	Helios is suitable for open field culture without support, has high yield potential and very firm uniform shaped fruit.
Disease resistance:	HR to ToMV, Xv 1,2,3, PVY
Key:	ToMV - Tomato Mosaic Virus Xv - Bacterial Leaf Spot (<i>Xanthomonas versicolor</i>) races PVY - Potato Virus 'Y'
